24 Hour Clock

To avoid confusion between AM and PM times, all timetables in this booklet use the 24 hour clock. Below is a table to help you

0600 = 6am	1000 = 10am	1400 = 2pm	1800 = 6pm	2100 = 9pm
0700 = 7am	1100 = 11am	1500 = 3pm	1900 = 7pm	2200 = 10pm

Timetable codes

When using the timetables in this booklet always check to see whether there are codes at the top of the journey columns. These give additional information about particular journeys, especially where they only run on certain days of the week. Common codes used within the timetable are as follows:

On public holidays services may be altered. Passengers are therefore advised to check before they travel. Over the Christmas period, there are no bus services on Christmas Day, Boxing Day or New Year's Day. On 2 January, a Sunday service will be provided on contracted services only.

Tickets

Buying a return ticket will usually save you money. However, please note that tickets issued by one operator are not always valid for return with another operator. Please check before buying your ticket.

Bus Stops/Hail and Ride Locations

You should always give a clear signal to the driver when you wish to get on or off the bus. Hail and Ride will operate at suitable safe locations.
