### Key principles of procurement legislation





#### What does this mean?

- One portal in Scotland to go to access opportunities
- Proportionate tendering processes based on complexity and value of requirements
- Lotting Strategies
- Sustainability at the core of what we deliver
- Contract register, Procurement Strategy and Annual Reports published



#### **Procurement Notices**

- Prior Information Notice
  - Provides advanced warning of forthcoming opportunities
- Contract Notice
  - Formal advert for live opportunity
- Contract Award Notice
  - Provides details of the contract awarded
- Quick Quote
  - Specific invite for suppliers to quote for lower value contracts
- Tender Documents
  - Documentation used to obtain formal offers which if successful constitute the contract itself following acceptance

# Dumfries and Galloway Council's Thresholds and Procedures

- £0 £1,999 for goods / services / works
- £2,000 £19,999 for goods / services / works
- £20,000 £49,999 for goods and services
- £20,000 £149,999 for works
- £50,000 £181,302 (OJEU threshold) for goods and services
- £150,000 £4,551,413 (OJEU threshold) for works
- Over EU Threshold



# How are tenders evaluated and what training is available?

- Stage one compliance with minimum criteria
- Stage two value for money with appropriate price / quality weighting
- Improve your chances of winning by clearly demonstrating how you meet the required standards and delivery requirements
- Supplier Development Programme



#### **The Award Process**

When awarding a contract the Council will provide:

- Award and decline letters
- Observe a standstill period where necessary
- Debrief
