Subject: EXTERNAL: Possible Disposal of Land at Low Boreland, Kirkcudbright.

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Dear Sir

I have read the notice that D&G Council have attached to a tree on some Common Good land at Low Boreland, Kirkcudbright.

I wish to object to any possible proposal to dispose of it.

1. It is Common Good land and I use this area for exercising my dog during the year, particularly the winter months. Being disabled, it is a very useful amenity. I do not wish that this land be sold off to private ownership.
2. Looking at the plan of the land to be disposed of, it appears to be very suitable for adding to the garden of the property "Low Boreland". This property is owned by an individual either connected with, or employed by, D&G Council.
3. The lane that leads to this area has a shared public access between the Common Good land and 5 properties.
4. In 2000-01 we enquired about a similar arrangement for a very small piece of Common Good land to the land in question and we were refused. Similar policies and approaches must apply both to members of the public and to those with Council connections.
