			refreshments served prior to core hours, 9am breakfasts for example. There may be occasions when sporting occasions the likes of international events are shown on television before or after core hours and this will provide the premises with compliance should it be requested by customers.' <u>Children and Young Persons</u> to read: TERMS – Children and Young Persons will be allowed on the premises. Children and Young Persons must always be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. AGES – Children 0-15; Young Persons 16 and 17 years TIMES – Children and Young Persons can remain on the premises until the terminal hour and must always be accompanied by a responsible adult. PARTS – Children and Young Persons can access all parts except the bar area and must always be under the supervision of a responsible adult.
